In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

Messaging Owner Jason Parker of Buffalo, N.Y.

having taken and subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo in the District of Buffalo Creek and is the Owner of the equal undivided one fourth part of the Schooner Arab of Buffalo and that John Stearns who resides at Milan Ohio is the Owner of the equal undivided one half part of said Schooner and that Charles A Ryan who resides at Milan Ohio is the Owner of the remaining equal undivided one fourth part of said Schooner and that all said Owners are Citizens of the United States, and sole purser & of the Arab of Buffalo whereof Jackson is at present Master; and as he has sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo New York in the year 1854, as appears by New last Enrollment dated at this Port May 1st 1855 No 28. Now I enclose hereby Changed Owners.

And the said Enrollment the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and two masts, and that her length is 101 feet 3 inches her breadth 23 feet 6 inches her depth 9 feet 6 inches and that she measures 204 tons 61 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner and a single stern head.

And the said Jason Parker having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
