In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo and that he together with Warren Sammis of said Buffalo, Virgil Killyer and Franklin B. Abbott of Jersey City New Jersey and Dennis R. Neal of Brooklyn, Ct. Y. who compose the firm of Williams Sammis & Co own 5/16ths of the Propeller J.W. Bractbury of Buffalo then & there alike - that Paul E. Sturtevant New Albany and S. Lewis H. Kimball all of said Buffalo own 1/16th of said Propeller then & there alike - that Samuel Morgan and Paisley A. Root of Buffalo and Sylvanus S. Wood of Albany who compose the firm of Morgan & Root own 1/16th of said Propeller then & there alike - that Franklin Williams of Buffalo owns the remaining 1/16th part of said Propeller Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Propeller called the J.W. Bractbury of Buffalo whereof Henry Counts is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built of Columbus, Ohio in the year 1855, as appears by the Certificate of his last Enrollment dated at this Port Nov 8 1855. No 233. Now surrendered having changed Owner.
