And said Certificate being having certified that the said Brig or Vessel has one deck and two masts; and that her length is 124 feet 6 inches her breadth 26 feet 5 inches her depth 10 feet 4 inches and that she measures 312 tons 26 - ninety-fifths that she is a Brig has no gallery stern and a scroll head.

And the said Henry C. Walker Post being having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
