In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, ~~amending the same~~; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Athens State of New York in the year 1854, ~~as appears by the~~ as a canal boat, and remodelled into a schooner at Buffalo N. Y. 1855 as appears by the certificate of her last enrollment dated at this port July 2d, 1855 now surrendered having changed owners - and

And said certificate ~~has been certified~~ having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and two masts, and that her length is 95 feet 0 inches her breadth 16 feet 6 inches her depth 7 feet 0 inches and that she measures 103 tons 44 - ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square stern and no figure head.

And the said John Keith having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
