And Chas. Reines Special Surveyor the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 130 feet 0 inches her breadth 28 feet 2 inches her depth 11 feet 2 inches and that she measures 374 tons 43 ninety-fifths that she is a Stem has a Square and figure — stern head.

And the said Henry C. Walker having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
