In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and ~~the Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam,~~ passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 20th, 1850, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

Francis D. Harrison

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo in said District and is a



Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Brig called the Helfenstein of Buffalo whereof said Harrison is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Milwaukee Wisconsin in the year 1847, as appears by the certificate of her last Enrollment dated at this Port March 22, 1856 No 28 now surrendered having changed names

And said certificate the said Brig or Vessel has one deck and two masts, and that her length is 130 feet 2 inches her breadth 26 feet 3 inches her depth 10 feet 5 inches and that she measures 329 tons 30 - ninety-fifths that she is a Brig has no gallery and a scull head.

And the said Francis D. Harrison having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
