



# ENROLLMENT.



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## District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1823, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

Henry C. Walker  
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo in said District and is the President of the Lake Navigation Company, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of New York located at said Buffalo, and said Company is the  
~~Citizen of the United States, and~~ sole owner of the Brig called the H. R. Seymour  
of Buffalo whereof M. Wright is at present Master; and as he has sworn  
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Three Mill Bay Jeff. W. State of New York in the year 1847, as appears by the Certificate of her last enrollment dated at this Port May 7. 1854. No. 50 crew surrendered having deigned owner.

agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
