



# ENROLLMENT.



## District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of the crews of board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1850, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

*Henry C. Walker*  
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo in said District and is President of the Lake Navigation Company, a Corporation located at Buffalo, organized under the laws of the State of New York; and that said Corporation is the

~~Citizen of the United States~~ and sole owner of the Schooner called the *Rival* of Buffalo whereof *R. R. Brown* is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo in the year 1856, as appears by the certificate of *J. N. Jones* Shipwright her builder on file in this office -

And *Chas Reeves* Special Surveyor having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has *one* deck and *two* masts and that her length is *130* feet *-* inches her breadth *29* feet *4* inches her depth *11* feet *7 1/2* inches and that she measures *403* tons *40* - ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a *square* stern/ head.

And the said *Henry C. Walker* and *an Eagle figure* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.

Given under my hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo, in the said District, this *18* day of *May* in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty *6*
