In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo in said District and is President of the Lake Navigation Company a corporation located at Buffalo organized under the laws of the State of New York, and that said Corporation is the ~~Citizen of the United States~~ owner of the Schooner called the ~~Henry B. Walker~~ whereof ~~Francis W. Hoffman~~ is at present Master; and as he has sworn ~~Citizen of the United States~~ and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo ~~State of New York~~ in the year 1856 as appears by ~~the~~ last enrollment dated ~~at that port~~ May 5 1856 No 15, New Numbered ~~having changed name.~~

And said enrollment ~~the said Schooner~~ or Vessel has ~~One~~ deck and ~~Two~~ having certified that her length is 137 feet 10 inches her breadth 26 feet 8 inches her depth 10 feet 8 inches and that she measures 353 tons 38 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner and has a square stern head. ~~And the said~~ Henry B. Walker and ~~Francis W. Hoffman~~ having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
