In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1839, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same, also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

Harvey M. Mixer
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo and is President of the Lake Navigation Company, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of New York located at Buffalo and said Company is the

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner called the Geo. Worthington of Buffalo whereof Oliver Ramsdell is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Euclid Creek State of New York Ohio in the year 1853, as appears by the certificate of her last Enrollment dated at the Port of Cleveland May 6, 1853. No. 24, now surrendered having changed owners -

her length is 120 feet 14 inches
her breadth 25 feet 3 inches
her depth 10 feet 11 inches
and that she measures 344 tons 54 ninety-fifths
that she is a Schooner has a square stern
and a figure head.

And the said H. M. Mixer Sect. having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
