the said Schooner or Vessel has *one* deck and *two* masts and that her length is *124* feet *6* inches her breadth *26* feet *3* inches her depth *10* feet *3* inches and that she measures *305* tons *47* ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square stern and no figure head.

And the said *Harvey M. Mixer* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
