In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 13th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo in said District and is the Secretary of the Lake Navigation Company a corporation organized under the laws of the State of New York located at Buffalo; and said corporation is the

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner — of the Schooner called the Altair of Buffalo whereof Robt. Kyle is at present Master; and as he has sworn Buffalo is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1855, as appears by the certificate of her last Enrollment dated at this Port Sept 12, 1855 No. 217 now surrendered having changed name —

And said certificate — having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and two masts, and that her length is 138 feet 0 inches her breadth 38 feet 2 inches her depth 11 feet 6 inches and that she measures 412 tons 85 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square stern and a scroll head.

And the said Harvey M. Mixer doth having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
