In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on land Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

~~Citizen of the United States~~, and sole owner of the Schooner called the Rebecca of Buffalo whereof said Walker is at present Master; and as he has sworn ~~Citizen of the United States~~ and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Toledo Ohio in the year 1853, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment dated at the Port of Toledo June 25, 1854 No 7 now surrendered having changed owners -

And ~~Schooner~~ Said Certificate the said ~~Schooner~~ or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 114 feet 4 inches her breadth 23 feet 2 inches her depth 10 feet 5 inches and that she measures 355 tons 11 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a stern head.

And the said H. C. Walker Past having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
