## District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo in said District and is President of The Lake Erie Transportation Company, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of New York located at Buffalo, and said company is

~~Citizen of the United States~~ and sole owner of the Steamboat called the *Minnesota* of Buffalo whereof *M. Russell* is at present Master; and as he has sworn ~~Citizen of the United States~~ and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Waukegan* in the year 1857, as appears by the certificate of her last Enrollment dated at this Port March 31, 1856 No. 38 now surrendered having changed owners

And said certificate the said Steamboat or Vessel has one deck and one mast, and that her length is 235 feet inches her breadth 30 feet 10 inches her depth 10 feet 8 inches and that she measures 749 tons 45 ninety-fifths that she is a Steam Boat has no gallery and no figures

And the said *A. P. Cobb* Post-  
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Steamboat has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
