## District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1850, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

Nelson Willard

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo in said District and is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the <sup>late</sup> Schooner, called the Acadia <sup>and now by Captain Prigo</sup> whereof Thomas Clarke is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Brownsville <sup>is a</sup> State of New York in the year 1847, as appears by the certificate of her last enrollment dated at the Port of Oswego April 29, 1853 <sup>AD. 18.</sup> now surrendered having changed owners,

And Said Enrollment the said ~~Schooner~~ <sup>Schooner</sup> Vessel has <sup>one</sup> deck and <sup>two</sup> masts, and that her length is 119 feet 9 inches her breadth 25 feet 9 inches her depth 10 feet 282 inches and that she measures 75 tons ninety-fifths that she is a ~~Schooner~~ <sup>Schooner</sup> has a square stern head.

And the said Nelson Willard having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said ~~Schooner~~ <sup>Schooner</sup> has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
