## District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 20th, 1852, ~~concerning the same~~; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

Clarke resides at said Buffalo and they both are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner <sup>each</sup> of the  $\frac{1}{2}$  part undivided of the Brig called the  
*Acadia of Buffalo* whereof said Clarke  
is at present Master; and as he has sworn  
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Brownsville <sup>is a</sup> State of  
New York in the year 1847, as appears by the certificate of her last Enrollment  
dated at this Port May 27. 1856. No 118 now surrendered having changed  
owners,

And said Certificate  
the said Brig or Vessel has one deck and two masts, and that  
her length is 119 feet 9 inches  
her breadth 25 feet 9 inches  
her depth 10 feet inches  
and that she measures 282 tons 75 ninety-fifths  
that she is a Schooner Brig has a square stern  
and no head.

And the said Nelson Willard  
agrees to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with  
the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
