In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cleveland State of Ohio in the year 1846, as appears by the certified copy of her last Enrollment now produced and surrendered, the original having been lost as appears by the oath of A. R. Cobb on file in this office. Said original having been issued from this office Dated May 22, 1855. No. 74

And said certificate having certified that the said Steamer or Vessel has one deck and one mast, and that her length is 214 feet 8 inches her breadth 32 feet inches her depth 12 feet inches and that she measures 75 tons 46 ninety-fifths that she is a Steamboat has a round stern head.

And the said A. R. Cobb Presb and having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Steamboat has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
