In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers and Board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo in the District of Buffalo Creek, and is Secretary of the Lake Navigation Company, a Corporation organized under the laws of the State of New York, and located at Buffalo; and said

company is 3 ~~Citizen~~ of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner called *the Petrel* of Buffalo whereof said *Mixer* is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo ^{is a} State of New York in the year 1847, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment dated at this Port April 12, 1854 No. 46 Now surrendered having changed owners

And said Certificate 3 having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 113 feet 6 inches her breadth 23 feet 4 inches her depth 8 feet 6 1/2 inches and that she measures 208 tons 7 - ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a stern head.

And the said *Harvey M. Mixer* Sub ^{and} having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
