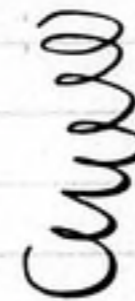


District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and ~~and an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam,~~ passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same ~~and an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam,~~ and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo and is the President of The Lake Navigation Company a corporation organized under the laws of the State of New York located at Buffalo and is the



Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner called the *Arcturus* of Buffalo whereof *H. A. Dix* is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Huron State of Ohio in the year 1853, as appears by the certificate of her last enrollment dated at this Port June 1, 1853 No 88 - now surrendered having changed owners

And said said certificate the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 140 feet 1 inches her breadth 28 feet 4 inches her depth 11 feet 3 inches and that she measures 412 tons 46 - ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square stern and a well head.

And the said *Henry C. Walker* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
