is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cleveland Ohio in the year 1856, as appears by the Certificate of her Enrollment Luther Moses Shipwright her builder on file in this office

And D. W. Cross Special surveyor appointed to measure said Propeller, he being at the Port of Cleveland Ohio

And ~~some Certificate~~ in the State of Ohio - having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has one deck and one mast, and that

her length is 200 feet 5 inches
her breadth 31 feet 09 inches
her depth 13 feet 12 inches
and that she measures 789 tons 12 ninety-fifths
