

ENROLLMENT.



District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

Carl S. Sternburg

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo and is President of The Western Transportation Company a Corporation organized under the laws of the State of New York, located at Tonawanda in this District; and that said Company is

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Propeller called the Tonawanda of Tonawanda whereof *J. B. Palmer* is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo New York in the year 1856, as appears by the certificate of *R. B. Stone* is a Shipwright her builder on file

And *P. Hoffman* Dept. Colr. having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has one deck and one mast, and that her length is 202 feet 9 inches her breadth 32 feet 3 inches her depth 13 feet 3 inches and that she measures 822 tons 65 ninety-fifths that she is a Propeller has a square stern and a scroll head.

And the said *Carl S. Sternburg* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
