In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and ~~"An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1833, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same;~~ also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

Josiah Kellogg

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Erie Pennsylvania which is more than 50 Miles distant from the Port of Buffalo by the usual travelled route, and has this day purchased from the builder thereof the Schooner "Huntress" now lying at the Port of Buffalo in the Dist. of Buffalo Creek and he is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the said Schooner Huntress of Erie whereof *Wesley Magill* is at present Master; and as he has sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo New York in the year 1856, as appears by the Certificate of George Hardman of Buffalo Shipwright her builder of Buffalo now on file in this office

And *Henry P. Clinton* Special Surveyor having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 127 feet 7 inches her breadth 28 feet 3 inches her depth 10 feet 8 inches and that she measures 357 tons 88 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square stern and a gun figure head.

And the said *Josiah Kellogg* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
