In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

Henry C. Walker,

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo and is President of the Lake Navigation Company, a Corporation created under the laws of the State of New York, located at Buffalo; and said company is

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~~Citizen of the United States~~ and sole owner of the Schooner called the Corinthian of Buffalo whereof H. M. Mizer is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at ~~New York~~ ^{Spring, Chateaugay Co.} State of New York in the year 1854, as appears by the Certificate of her builder Charles Stevens Shipwright on file in this office

And H. M. Mizer ^{the Dist. of Dunkirk to admeasure said Schooner she being in said Dist.} Measure appointed by the Collector of the Customs of having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has one 2 deck and two masts and that her length is 136 feet 5 inches her breadth 26 feet 2 inches her depth 11 feet 1 inches and that she measures 368 tons 83 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square stern and no figure head.

And the said Henry C. Walker agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
