

ENROLLMENT.



District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1850, amending the same, also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

Cleveland Forbes of Buffalo
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo and is President of The Buffalo & Toledo Transportation Company a corporation, located at said Buffalo, and organized under the laws of the State of New York, and said company is

~~the sole owner~~ of the Propeller called the *Crosses* of Buffalo whereof *Gorden F. Shattuck* is at present Master; and as he has sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo in the year 1856, as appears by the certificate of *J. N. Jones* Shipwright her builder on file in this office

And *Henry P. Clinton* Special Surveyor having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has one deck and one mast, and that her length is 179 feet 4 inches her breadth 36 feet 2 inches her depth 11 feet 6 inches and that she measures 588 tons 72- ninety-fifths that she is a Propeller has a square round stern and no figure head.

And the said *C. Forbes Pres* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
