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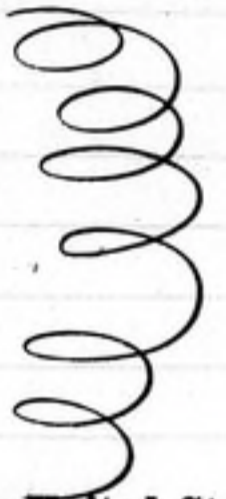

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and ~~"An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838,~~ and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending ~~the same~~; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

And said Certificate the said Ferryboat or Vessel has one deck and no mast, and that her length is 121 feet 11 inches her breadth 311 feet 4 inches her depth 9 feet 8 inches and that she measures 316 tons 11 ninety-fifths head. that she is a Steamboat has a 2 and no

And the said Wm Kason having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Steamboat has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
