## District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 20th, 1852, amending the same, and the act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo N. Y.  
and is President of The Buffalo & Toledo Transportation Company  
of Buffalo, a corporation organized under the laws of the State  
of New York, located at Buffalo; and said Company is

Citizen of the United States and sole owner of the Propeller called the  
Cuphrates of Buffalo whereof George Long is a  
is at present Master; and as he has sworn  
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of  
New York in the year 1856, as appears by the certificate of Jacob W.  
Banta Shipwright her builder on file in this office -

And H. P. Clinton Surveyor  
the said Propeller or Vessel has one deck and one mast, and that  
her length is 178 feet inches  
her breadth 30 feet inches  
her depth 11 feet 8 inches  
and that she measures 584 tons 35 ninety-fifths  
that she is a Propeller has a round stern  
and no head.

And the said C. Forbes Push.  
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with  
the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
