## District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers and board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same, also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

William J. Miller of Buffalo

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo in the District of Buffalo and is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the

Schooner *Amber* whereof *J. M. P. R.*

is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Ashafula* in the year 1850, as appears by *Ohio* in the year 1854, No. 59, the original having been withheld by the former owners and now deposited and authenticated by letter from the Secretary of the Treasury dated Aug 15, 1854, on file in the office of said certificate

the said Schooner or Vessel has *27* deck and *Two* masts, and that her length is *48* feet *3* inches her breadth *4* feet *0* inches her depth *4* feet *3* inches and that she measures *27* tons *64* and that she is a *Schooner* has a *Square* Stern and a *Stern* head.

And the said *William J. Miller* and *J. M. P. R.* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Schooner* has been duly Enrolled at the **Port of Buffalo, N. Y.**
