In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, ~~and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers and the Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July 1828 and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the~~ also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Onwego* State of *New York* in the year 1853, as appears by the certificate of her last Enrollment dated at the Port of *Onwego* August 17. 1856 No 30. now surrendered having changed names -

And - said Enrollment - having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and two masts, and that her length is 90 feet - inches her breadth 23 feet - inches her depth 10 feet - inches and that she measures 188 tons - ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square stern head.

And the said *E. A. Bruce* and *P. Hoffman* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
