Jaybrook State of Ohio in the year 1856, as appears by the Certificate of D. J. Hendrick Master Builder her builder on file in this Office

And H. P. Clinton Special Surveyor having certified that the said Scow Schooner or Vessel has one deck and two masts, and that her length is 101 feet 6 inches her breadth 25 feet 2 inches her depth 8 feet 4 inches and that she measures 190 tons that she is a Scow Schooner and has a square stern and plain head.

And the said William Peck having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
