In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers and board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1850, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner called the Elizabeth of Buffalo whereof said Peck is at present Master and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Seneca Falls State of New York in the year 1847, as appears by a Canalboat in in the year 1855 at Buffalo altered into Schooner as appears by the certificate of her last Enrollment dated at this Port July 16, 1855 No. 147 now surrendered having changed names

And said Certificate the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and two masts, and that her length is 78 feet inches her breadth 14 feet 6 inches her depth 5 feet 4 inches and that she measures 57 tons 12 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square stern and no figure head.

And the said William Peck having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
