In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

Harvey M. Mixer
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo and is Secretary of the Lake Navigation Company a corporation organized under the laws of the State of New York located at Buffalo and that said company is the

sole owner of the Schooner called the Kate L. Bruce of Buffalo whereof Alexr. - farmer is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo - State of New York in the year 1856, as appears by the certificate of her last enrollment dated at this Port Oct 4 - 1856 No 194 now surrendered having changed owners

And said Certificate - 3
the said Schooner or Vessel has one - deck and two - masts, and that her length is 122 feet - inches her breadth 26 feet - inches her depth 10 feet - inches and that she measures 310 - tons 78 ninety-fifths that she is a - Schooner - has a square - stern head.

And the said Schooner H. M. Mixer Port - having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner - has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
