Mixer - is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Detroit* State of *Michigan* in the year 1855, as appears by the Certificate of the last Enrollment dated at the Port of *Detroit* - May 31, 1855 No 61. now surrendered having changed owners

And said Certificate the said *Propeller* or Vessel has *one* deck and *no* mast, and that her length is *102* feet *0* inches her breadth *22* feet *2* inches her depth *7* feet *3* inches and that she measures *150* tons *14* ninety-fifths that she is a *Log Propeller* has *no* galley and *no* figure head.

And the said *H. C. Walker Pres.* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Propeller* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
