In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 26th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

Sibley of Buffalo whereof he is at present Master; and as he has sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1847, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment dated at Chicago Illinois June 17, 1856 - No. 72. Now Surrendered the same having become void by reason of the arrival of the vessel in this port the residence of her owner.

And said Certificate -  
the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and two masts, and that her length is 114 feet 11 inches her breadth 24 feet 7 inches her depth 9 feet 11 inches and that she measures 252 tons 18 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner and has a square stern head. as scroll

And the said Charles M. Averill agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
