In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same, also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

Rufus R. Johnson -  
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo in the District of Buffalo Creek and is the managing owner of the Brig Acadia; that Isaac N. Fisher resides at said Buffalo; that Estham A. Bruce resides at Chicago Illinois; that they are all

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the <sup>each 1/3 part undivided of the Brig</sup> called the ~~Acadia~~ Acadia of Buffalo whereof he is at present Master; and as he has sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Brownsville - State of New York in the year 1847, as appears by the certificate of her last Enrollment dated at this port February 7. 1857 - No. 7 - now surrendered having changed owners -
