

ENROLLMENT.



District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

Edward Morris

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo in the District of Buffalo Creek and is the owner of $\frac{5}{8}$ parts undivided of the Schooner Arab of Buffalo and is the managing owner of said Schooner and that Hugh Mallon resides at said Buffalo and owns the remaining $\frac{3}{8}$ parts of said Schooner, and they both are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the said Schooner Arab of Buffalo whereof said Mallon is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo New York in the year 1854, as appears by the certificate of her last Enrollment dated at this Port May 1. 1856 No. 12 now surrendered having changed owners

And said Certificate the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 101 feet 3 inches her breadth 23 feet 6 inches her depth 9 feet 11 inches and that she measures 204 tons 61 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square stern and a scroll head.

And the said Edward Morris agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
