## District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1832, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act, entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

Rufus R. Johnson

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, and is the Managing owner of the Brig Venice of Buffalo, and owns 1/2 part undivided of said Brig and that Catharine B. Bruce resides at Chicago in the State of Illinois and owns the remaining 1/2 part undivided of said Brig and that they are

Citizens of the United States, and sole owners of the said Brig Venice of Buffalo whereof said Catharine B. Bruce is at present Master; and as he has sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Rochester - New York in the year 1857, as appears by the certificate of the last Enrollment of the said Brig dated at this Port Sept. 20. 1847 No. 103 now surrendered having changed owners,

And said certificate the said Brig or Vessel has one deck and two masts, and that her length is 116 feet 5 inches her breadth 25 feet 3 inches her depth 9 feet 5 inches and that she measures 253 tons 43 ninety-fifths that she is a Brig has a square stern and a scroll head.

And the said Rufus R. Johnson having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.

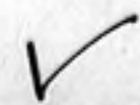
