In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 13th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and ~~an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers and local Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam,~~ passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, ~~amending the same;~~ also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

Citizen's of the United States, and sole owners of the Share & share alike of the Steam Tug called the *Uncle Ben* of Buffalo whereof said Leander W. Meyer is at present Master; and as he has sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo New York in the year 1856, as appears by the certificate of her last Enrollment dated at this Port Oct. 14 1856 - No 199 now Surrendered having changed owners

And said Certificate having certified that the said Tug or Vessel has one deck and no mast, and that her length is 95 feet inches her breadth 20 feet 5 inches her depth 9 feet inches and that she measures 155 tons 31 ninety-fifths that she is a Steam Tug has a round stern and no fore head.

And the said Jacob W. Banta H. M. Meyer having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Tug has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
