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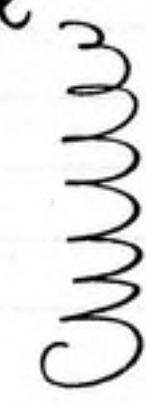


District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

Charles Ensign

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo Dist of Buffalo Creek, that George W. Holt resides at said Buffalo; that Charles Marsden and Elias Merchant both reside at Cleveland Ohio; that they are all



Citizen of the United States, and sole owner ^{each 1/4} of the ^{the} part undivided of the Propeller called the Pittsburgh of Buffalo whereof James L. Breckwith is at present Master; and as he has sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cleveland State of Ohio in the year 1856, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment dated at this Port March 6. 1857 No 15 now surrendered having changed owners

And said Certificate having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has one deck and two masts, and that her length is 186 7/8 feet inches her breadth 27 5/8 feet inches her depth 2 3/4 feet inches and that she measures 606 tons 11 - ninety-fifths that she is a Propeller and has a square stern head.

And the said Charles Ensign having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
