District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act, entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

Milo R. Barnes of Buffalo -
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo in the District of Buffalo, and that he did on the 2^d day of March 1857 at the City of Buffalo in said District bid of and purchase the Schooner Clyde of Buffalo she then & still being at said Buffalo, at public auction, and said purchase was made by him in good faith as the agent of and on account of Sylvester Hale who resided and still resides at Albany New York, more than 50 miles distant from the Port of Buffalo; that said Hale ~~at the time of said purchase~~ is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner called the Clyde of Buffalo whereof M. R. Barnes is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Huron Ohio in the year 1856, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment dated at this Port July 17, 1856 - No 167 now surrendered having changed owners.

And said Certificate -
the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 122 feet 6 inches her breadth 25 feet 4 inches her depth 11 feet 9 inches and that she measures 317 tons 56 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square stern and plain head.

And the said M. R. Barnes agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
