



ENROLLMENT.



District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

John Watson -

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo in the District of Buffalo Creek, and is a



Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner called the Fashion of Buffalo whereof he is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Milan Ohio in the year 1847, as appears by the Certificate of her Enrollment dated at the Port of Milwaukee July 13, 1855 - No 45 - now surrendered having changed owners

And said Certificate

the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and two masts, and that her length is 108 feet 10 inches her breadth 23 feet 10 inches her depth 9 feet 6 inches and that she measures 223 tons 85 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square stern and a figure head.

And the said John Watson having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
