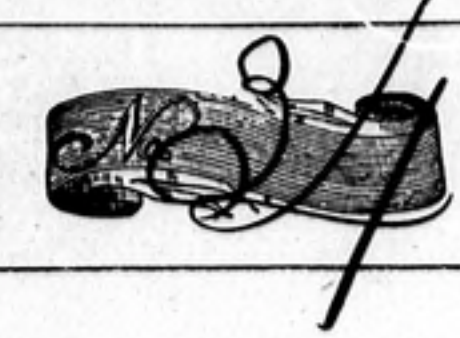




# ENROLLMENT.



## District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

Albert Kosmer Junior  
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn, that he resides at Buffalo N.Y. and that James W. Louttit resides at the same place that they both are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner <sup>each</sup> of the  $\frac{1}{2}$  part undivided of the Brig called the Buffalo of Buffalo whereof said Louttit is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cleveland Ohio in the year 1848, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment dated at this Port March 7, 1856 No. 15 - now surrendered having changed owners

And the said Certificate - having certified that the said Brig or Vessel has one deck and two masts, and that her length is 118 feet  $\frac{1}{2}$  inches her breadth 24 feet 2 inches her depth 9 feet 8 inches and that she measures 263 tons 79 ninety-fifths that she is a Brig has a square stern and a scroll head.

And the said A. Kosmer Jr. having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
