In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1850, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo in the District of Buffalo Creek, and is the President of "The Lake Navigation Company, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of New York and located at Buffalo in said District; and that said Company is the

~~Citizen of the United States~~ and sole owner - of the Schooner called the Dardanells of Buffalo whereof said Master is at present Master; and as he has sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Milan State of Ohio in the year 1856, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment dated at the Port of Sandusky July 7th 1856 No. 36 now surrendered having changed owners

And said Certificate the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and two masts, and that her length is 121 feet 6 inches her breadth 24 feet 10 inches her depth 11 feet 1 inch and that she measures 308 tons 8 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square stern and figure head.

And the said H. C. Walker, having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
