



ENROLLMENT.



District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on Board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

Rufus R. Johnson -

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo in the District of Buffalo Creek, and owns 1/2 part undivided of the Schooner Cathan Allen of Buffalo, and that Cathan A Bruce of Buffalo Chicago owns the remaining 1/2 part undivided of said Schooner, and that they both are Citizens of the United States, and sole owners of the said Schooner called the Cathan Allen of Buffalo whereof Johnson is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo N.Y. in the year 1857, as appears by the certificate of J. N. Jones shipwright her builder on file in this office.

And *Wm. W. Wier* Surveyor to measure said Schooner the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and two her length is 122 feet 9 inches her breadth 36 feet 9 inches her depth 11 feet 1 inch and that she measures 389 tons 91 that she is a Schooner has a square stern and a beak.

And the said *R. R. Johnson* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
