



ENROLLMENT.



District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 13th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1834, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

Frederick A. Bellinger -
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo Dist
of Buffalo Creek and owns 7/8th parts undivided of the Schooner
Dahlia of Buffalo; that William Campbell of
Sandusky Ohio owns the remaining 1/8th part undivided
of said Schooner; And that they both are

Citizen & of the United States, and sole owners of the Schooner called the Dahlia
of Buffalo whereof Wm Campbell
is at present Master; and as he has sworn
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Ashtabula State of
Ohio in the year 1847, as appears by the certificate of her last
Enrollment dated at this Port February 28. 1854 No. 26
Now surrendered having changed owners

And said Enrollment -
the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and two masts, and that
her length is 106 feet 1 inches
her breadth 33 feet 11 inches
her depth 9 feet 1 inches
and that she measures 210 tons 25 ninety-fifths
that she is a Schooner has a square stern/
and a scroll head.

And the said Frederick A. Bellinger
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with
the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
