In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on Board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1850, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

Albert Kosner Jr.
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo
in the District of Buffalo Creek and is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the *Scow Schooner* called the
Oak Hill of Buffalo whereof *John B. Ross*
is at present Master; and as he has sworn
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Dunbrook* is a
Ohio in the year 1857, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment
dated at this Port *October 29, 1856* No. 289 now
surrendered having changed owners

And said Certificate
the said *Schooner* or Vessel has *one* deck and *two* masts, and that
her length is *101* feet *6* inches
her breadth *25* feet *2* inches
her depth *8* feet *4* inches
and that she measures *190* tons
that she is a *Scow Schooner* has a *square* stern/
and a *plain* head.

And the said *A. Kosner Jr.*
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with
the terms of the said acts, the said *Scow Schooner* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
