



# ENROLLMENT.

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## District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1834, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August, 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

John H. Myers Managing owner,  
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo  
in the District of Buffalo Creek, that John G. Gibson, and  
G. John C. Wohnert reside at the same place; that they  
are all

Citizen of the United States, and sole owners of the <sup>each 1/3<sup>rd</sup> part undivided of the Schooner called</sup>  
the Senny Lunde of Buffalo - whereof George Warner  
is at present Master; and as he has sworn  
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cleveland - <sup>is a</sup> State of  
Ohio in the year 1848, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment  
dated at the Port of Cleveland Ohio March 21. 1854 No 6 now  
surrendered having changed owners;

And said Certificate  
the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and two masts, and that  
her length is 88 feet 3 inches  
her breadth 20 feet 8 inches  
her depth 8 feet 9 inches  
and that she measures 144 tons 67 ninety-fifths  
that she is a Schooner has a Square stern/  
and a Scroll head.

And the said J. H. Myers -  
having  
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with  
the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
