

ENROLLMENT.



District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

Jacob W. Banta -
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo Port Dist of Buffalo Creek and Vincent Bidwell and Benjamin Bidwell reside at the same place, and that they all are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the *Steamboat* called the *City of Cleveland* of Buffalo whereof *James Lundy* is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo New York in the year 1857, as appears by the Certificate of *J. W. Banta* Shipwright her builder on file in this office;

And *William W. Hunt* surveyor having measured said Vessel and having certified that the said Steamboat or Vessel has one deck and two masts, and that her length is 227 feet 9 inches her breadth 35 feet 5 inches her depth 11 feet 9 inches and that she measures 788 tons 15 ninety-fifths that she is a Steamboat has a square stern and a scroll head.

And the said *J. W. Banta* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Steamboat has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
