In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo and is President of the Lake Navigation Company of Buffalo a corporation organized under the laws of the State of New York, and said said Company is the

~~Citizen of the United States, and~~ sole owner of the Schooner called the *Star Bird of Buffalo* whereof is at present Master; and as he has sworn *Buffalo* is a State of *New York* Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Buffalo* in the year 1857, as appears by the certificate of *J. M. Banta* Shipwright her builder on file in this office

And *Wm. Wheat* Surveyor appointed to measure said Schooner having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has *one* deck and *two* masts, and that her length is *137* feet *10* inches her breadth *26* feet *8* inches her depth *11* feet *2* inches and that she measures *381* tons *79* - ninety-fifths that she is a *Schooner* has a *Square* stern head and a *plain* head.

And the said *H. C. Walker* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
