In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

H. C. Walker
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo and is President of the Lake Navigation Company a corporation located at Buffalo organized under the laws of the State of New York; and said Company is the

~~Citizen~~ of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner called the Samuel of Buffalo whereof Harry Bower is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo, N. Y. in the year 1857, as appears by the certificate of R. B. Jones Shipwright, her builder on file in this Office.

And R. H. Best Surveyor appointed to measure said vessel having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has One deck and Two masts, and that her length is 136 feet 0 inches her breadth 30 feet 0 inches her depth 11 feet 0 inches and that she measures 437 tons 80, ninety-eight stow head. that she is a Schooner and a Sloop.

And the said Harry C. Walker having agreed to the description and measurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
