In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers and Board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1853, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same, also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

John Lane,

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at *Pittsfield*
State of Mass, and is the owner of *3/4* part
individually of the Schooner *Carrington* of Buffalo
and *Henry G. Morry* of Buffalo *N.Y.* is the owner
of the remaining *1/4* part undivided of said vessel

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner called the
Carrington of Buffalo whereof
is at present Master; and as he has sworn
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Ohio* *feity* is a
Ohio in the year 1853, as appears by the certificate of her last *State of*
Licensure dated at this port *May 16 1857* No *84* No
Amended having changed name

And *John* said Certificate *Henry* having certified that
the said Schooner or Vessel has *One* deck and *Two* masts, and that
her length is *120* feet *9* inches
her breadth *24* feet *9* inches
her depth *10* feet *inches*
and that she measures *275* tons *45* ninety-fifths
that she is a Schooner has a *Square* stern
and *No figure* head.

And the said *John Lane* having
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with
the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
